Dangerous Margins with Chris Robertson

Despite attempts to make society safe, we live in an increasingly dangerous world in which the banished wild at the margins threatens our tamed culture. Psychotherapy has long explored events that constellate at margins but may now be retreating from the 'forbidden zone'.

This series of afternoons will explore a number of themes in relation to working therapeutically at these margins including: *Rupture, Inferiority, Shadow, Borderlands/Liminality, Story and Renewal*. In evoking the marginal, we can anticipate the presence of Hermes.

The overall aim will be to learn to engage the danger, grasp the nettle, in order to vitalize our practice and recognize how therapy is itself operating at the margins of the collective. Each session will involve reflection on the theme followed by practical coaching with client work.

Chris Robertson has been a psychotherapist and trainer since 1978. His training background includes Psychosynthesis, Child Psychotherapy and Family Therapy. He is co-author of *Emotions and Needs* (OUP) and co-founder of Re•Vision. He has been the convener of the Re•Vision conference, *Sacred Margins* (2009) and the co-creator of the workshop *Borderlands and the Wisdom of Uncertainty*, which in 1989 became the subject of a BBC documentary. He works in London at Re•Vision and also offers 'Emergent Space' workshops in Sweden and the Netherlands.
